Green mobility

We want to prioritize train travel as a sustainable option, and also offering financial incentives and information to encourage students to choose greener transportation alternatives

Inclusive mobility

We want inclusive mobility that ensures access for all, promoting gender balance, financial support for disadvantaged groups, and language courses for smooth integration.



Online mobility

We only want online mobility that complements, not replaces, physical mobility, which is essential for cultural exchange, personal growth, and academic enrichment.

During mobility, students need support for cultural exchange, local integration, and social connections. Post-mobility, experiences should be recognized academically.
