1 About the call

The objective of the Circle U. seed-funding scheme is **to foster new collaborations across universities in the Circle U. alliance**. It is a mechanism that provides academic and research staff, administrative/professional staff and students with opportunities to develop projects across the alliance, to strengthen the alliance and to drive bottom-up initiatives. The ultimate goal of funding smaller scale, limited in time, bottom-up projects, is to facilitate the initiation of potential long-term collaborative activities within the alliance, which are contributing to the fulfilment of [Circle U.'s vision and mission](#). These projects go thus beyond the deliverables defined in the current EU-funded project and will anchor Circle U. sustainably in all institutions.

For the 2026 Call for applications, educational and research projects, as well as student-led projects (i.e. projects led by BA and MA students), will be supported as detailed below.

2 Scope

The seed-funding scheme aims to achieve the **following goals**:

- 1 Drive bottom-up initiatives to embed the alliance within our universities' communities
- 2 Consolidate our [joint ecosystem](#) – the Open Campus, the Knowledge Hubs and the Platforms
- 3 Advance strategic research and education fields – not exclusively those already addressed by Circle U.'s [Knowledge Hubs](#) and Platforms
- 4 Develop high-quality and impactful educational and research activities, with a particular focus on interdisciplinarity, multilingualism, interculturality and student-led innovation
- 5 Scale up joint educational offers delivered through the Open Campus
- 6 Develop joint research collaborations, including those built during other Circle U. activities (such as Circle U. Sandpits)
- 7 Engage with our [associated partners](#) and other stakeholders in the innovation, cultural, health, governmental and NGO sectors to ensure that Circle U. activities have concrete societal impact
- 8 Enhance the mobility and international exposure of students, academics, researchers and staff across our universities
- 9 Foster sustainability, talent development, entrepreneurship, societal engagement, as well as equity, diversity and inclusion

3 Examples of activities that can be funded

Circle U. seed-funding scheme aims to support the **developmental stages of a project at an early stage**. Therefore, seed funded projects fit under a **wide variety of definitions**. Examples of what could constitute a seed-funded project within the context of the alliance include, but are not limited to:

For educational and research projects:

- joint courses and programmes
- educational activities according to Circle U.'s educational formats, including ECTS-bearing activities
- challenge-based learning activities
- winter or summer schools
- short-term physical or blended mobility opportunities

- workshops or seminars or any other teaching/learning activity
- innovative teaching models
- public lectures
- language workshops or seminars
- seminars, workshops and conferences targeting early-career researchers
- (preliminary) research activities
- surveys, creation of database, development of research materials
- awareness-raising material for the alliance (e.g. digital brochures or videos, etc.)
- joint large-scale project proposals to be submitted at European or other calls

For **student-led projects** (i.e. projects led by BA or MA students):

- support student-driven learning activities
- foster student democracy and student engagement in partner universities
- dissemination of Circle U. towards students
- learning and training activities
- cultural activities across Circle U.
- further develop and implement projects linked to other Circle U. opportunities (for example, the change maker's programme)

The list above is **non-exhaustive**, the selection committee will consider applications suggesting other activities too, provided that they clearly state how they match the scope of the seed-funding scheme.

4 Eligibility

The 2026 Call for applications is **open to academic and research staff from all disciplines and levels** working at any Circle U. member universities¹, to administrative/professional staff, as well as to **students working or being enrolled** at any Circle U. member universities. Projects should involve staff or students **from at least 3 Circle U. member universities**.

Each application shall be submitted by a **Project Lead**, appointed by the project members and acting as the point of contact with Circle U. for any questions relating to the project. Project Leads shall be employed as full-time or part-time academic and research staff at any of the Circle U. member universities, with the employment contract lasting for the full length of the proposed project. Within her/his home university, the Project Lead should hold a position that enables her/him to manage the grant independently and supervise funding and expenditures.

Students acting as Project Lead shall be enrolled at any Circle U. member universities for the full duration of the proposed project. Please note that external stakeholders may not act as Project Lead.

5 Selection process and evaluation criteria

With the support of the Circle U. Office, a **selection committee** consisting of 10 to 15 academics from the Circle U. member universities and representatives of the Circle U. Student Union (CUSU) will:

- Evaluate the proposals
- Inform the Circle U. Management Board about the selection of the proposals to be funded, as the Management Board is the ultimate decision-making body for alliance operations
- Assess post-implementation reports from projects which have been funded

Applications need to clearly outline how they fit into the scope of the Circle U. seed-funding scheme and how they match the objectives, vision and mission of Circle U. Additionally, the selection committee will give particular attention to the **following criteria**:

- Academic quality, innovativeness and interdisciplinarity of the proposed project
- Clear pathway for progress and impact on education, research and/or society
- Feasibility of the proposed project and sustainability of its budget
- Impact on Circle U. universities, their communities and broader society
- Long-term and sustainable collaborations beyond the proposed project
- Commitment to equality, diversity and inclusion
- Direct involvement of and benefits for students
- Engagement with multiple Circle U. member universities, associated partners and other stakeholders

The selection committee reserves the right to add selection criteria according to the quality of the applications received. Following the communication of the results, project leads of successful and unsuccessful proposals can request the evaluation report with succinct comments/recommendations by email to seedfunding@circle-u.eu.

6 Budget

The **total budget** available for the 2026 Call for applications is **EUR 100.000**. The budget is assigned in the following way:

Budget allocated to academic and research projects	EUR 90.000	Up to EUR 10.000 can be awarded per project
Budget allocated to student-led projects	EUR 10.000	Up to EUR 5.000 can be awarded per project

Funding will be transferred **as a lump sum by the Circle U. Office to the Project Lead's designated entity** (university, faculty, department, etc.). The Project Lead has the responsibility to manage the grant independently and supervise funding and expenditures and take care of the reporting.

All activities foreseen in the project have to be primarily funded by the grant, with the exception of travel expenses and/or costs of living for teaching or conducting research activities that are eligible for Erasmus+ individual mobility. If there is any complementary funding needed (for example, Erasmus+ funding to support additional mobilities), the Project Lead should ensure that the complementary funding is actually available at his or her home university and partner universities when elaborating the project budget. In this perspective, we strongly recommend the Project Lead to consult her or his financial department, as well as the Circle U. coordinator of her or his university.

Double funding is not allowed.

Eligible costs:

- temporary staff or consultant recruitment to support the project's activities by providing services (such as creating a database, benchmarking specific to the entity, conducting surveys, etc.)
- (preliminary) research activities
- awareness-raising materials for the alliance
- travel expenses and/or costs of living for teaching or conducting research activities related to the project, only if they cannot be covered by Erasmus+ staff mobility

Non-eligible costs:

- hiring of contractual administrative, research or academic staff
- remuneration of project partners
- overhead costs
- equipment costs
- conference fees

9 Communication, dissemination and reporting

Project Leads are expected to **communicate and disseminate the project’s results**, outputs, and outcomes by providing targeted information to multiple audiences in a strategic and effective manner. This might include a final dissemination event. Additionally, selected projects will feature on Circle U. website and a social media communication campaign promoting the projects will be organised by the Circle U. Office.

Project Leads are requested to submit a **report on implemented activities and incurred expenses** at the end of the funding period. Reports will be submitted by email to seedfunding@circle-u.eu by 31 January 2028. A template will be shared with the Project Lead by the Circle U. team coordinating the seed-funding Call.

Aarhus Universitet (Denmark), Humboldt-Universität zu Berlin (Germany), King's College London (United Kingdom), Università di Pisa (Italy), Universität Wien (Austria), Université catholique de Louvain (Belgium), Université Paris Cité (France), Universitetet i Oslo (Norway) and Univerzitet u Beogradu (Serbia) are Circle U.: an inclusive, research-intensive, and interdisciplinary European University alliance working to provide outstanding education, research, and innovation to contribute to more sustainable, democratic, and healthier societies. In 2020, we have joined forces to develop a new model of cooperation where education, research, innovation and service to society are better connected. During the pilot project (from November 2020 to October 2023) funded through Erasmus+ programme, we have worked closely with students, academics, researchers, staff and external stakeholders to test and identify new challenge-based educational formats and ways of working together to make Circle U. an international, inclusive, innovative and agile joint ecosystem.

In the next phase and through a new EU funded project in the coming four years, whilst continuously testing out new concepts in higher education and research cooperation, we will also scale up and offer a range of flexible learning opportunities, intensify our collaborations in all three missions and maximize our impacts through our joint ecosystem.

To fulfil our vision and mission, we have been developing a joint ecosystem offering a shared infrastructure as foundation for sustainable, impactful and ambitious collaborations across our universities. In the next phase, with the support of the academic chairs, we will consolidate and further develop this joint ecosystem and its core platforms to drive our vision towards a truly European University:

- The **Open Campus** will serve as the entry point for all educational opportunities in Circle U. This integrated digital learning platform will be at the heart of Circle U., linking together the various other platforms, including services to support mobility and facilitate the administrative and technical implementation.
- Launched in the pilot phase, the **Knowledge Hubs** are shared physical and virtual spaces where academics, researchers, students, staff and partners are developing research-based, trans- and interdisciplinary educational and research activities to tackle big societal challenges linked to our four priority themes: artificial intelligence, climate, democracy and global health.
- Building on the results of the Think and Do Tank, the **Circle U. Teaching Innovation Lab (CU.til)** will support the development of innovative and creative teaching and learning formats that focus on research-based, trans-, and interdisciplinary knowledge and societal engagement. The CU.til will connect teaching and learning support units across our universities and encourages research in education.
- The **Circle U. Multilingualism, Interculturality and Language Lab (CU.mil)** will support the development of a multilingual, plurilingual and intercultural environment within the alliance and beyond, by sharing experiences and existing offers, developing joint courses and other language and intercultural learning experiences (including for less frequently used languages), and developing a language policy for the alliance.
- Building on the results of the Student-led sustainable innovation initiatives, the **InCU.bator** will offer a structured space and concrete support opportunities for students in developing innovative projects with a societal impact. It will thus put students at the centre of societal innovation and, with the support of external partners, foster an entrepreneurial mindset in the broad sense.
- Built on the results of the early-career researchers' forum, the **Community of Practice for Early-Career Researchers (CU.ecr)** will provide early-career researchers with opportunities for networking, exchanges, competence building, mobility as well as developing and maturing their research interests in close collaboration with colleagues from Circle U. The activities will be characterised by co-creative modes of cooperation.
